QUESTION: What are the current figures in the number of First Nation teachers in Yukon?

ANSWER: The Yukon Bureau of Statistics reports that, as of March 31, 2016, the percentage of First Nations people in teaching positions is 19.1%.

QUESTION: How many temporary teachers have been teaching for more than two years in temporary positions?

ANSWER: The number of temporary teachers who have been employed for more than two continuous school years in a temporary position is 12.
