The response is as follows:
Two Requests for Proposals (RFP) for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection, handling, shipping and disposal were issued April 9, 2015. One was for coordination of HHW events, plus handling and disposal from Municipalities, and one was for collection and disposal of HHW from unincorporated sites. These RFPs resulted in Standing Offer Agreements (SOA) to be established with two local contractors; KBL Environmental Ltd, and Northern Enviro Services. These SOAs will expire March 29, 2018. Community Services intends to issue new RFPs in February of 2018.
