In September of 2016, Yukon Emergency Medical Services (EMS) redeployed a regional EMS supervisor from Whitehorse to Watson Lake as part of a pilot program to address issues relating to EMS coverage in that community.
Review of the pilot program in September 2017 has shown that Watson Lake benefits from this arrangement. The pilot program and the incumbent's term of service has been extended to the end of fiscal year 2017-18 at which time it will be evaluated again.
