The response is as follows:

The contract of \$22,000 with Appendo Learning Systems for Be A Responsible Server (BARS) was not specifically for the legalization of cannabis. Work under the contract was to transition the existing paper and classroom based BARS liquor server training to an online learning platform that will provide more delivery options for licensees and servers. The work is ongoing and the course will be available as an online learning option in 2019. The contract includes an annual hosting and maintenance fee for the web platform (\$11,000 of the total).

Although the contract in question was directly related to development of online liquor server training, the work laid the foundation for YLC to use the platform to develop and offer a similar Be A Responsible Server course for cannabis, aimed at staff and future licensees working in the legal cannabis sector in Yukon. The corporation developed a cannabis server-training course and uploaded it to the Appendo Learning Systems platform in 2018/19. This mandatory course was delivered to all corporation staff in preparation for sales on October 17, 2018. The online server-training course will be made available in early 2019 for interested private retailers and prospective staff interested in working in the non-medical cannabis retail sector in Yukon.
