Temporary (1-year) Employees in Terms or Temp. Assignments:	5 FTE (1 year)	(store)
Temporary, Auxiliary (on call, as needed)	3	(store)
Permanent (two, 0.5 FTE equivalent)	1 FTE (perm)	(warehouse)

Shared Services: In addition to the above dedicated cannabis positions, a number of existing YLC positions have a role with cannabis in shared service capacity. i.e. President's Office, Human Resources, Finance, Policy, Social Responsibility, Licensing and Inspections and Operations. These pre-existing, shared positions, are allocated to cannabis based on day-to-day operational requirements and activity.
